

Our Commitment to You

We take the privacy and confidentiality of all data subjects and visitors seriously. That is why we promise to respect the privacy of personal data, to remain transparent, and to keep your data safe.

1. Overview

Omniscope LTD, which is headquartered at 30/1, Kenilworth Court, Sir Augustus Bartolo Street, Ta'Xbiex, XBX 1093, Malta and its subsidiaries, including, without limitation Omniscope España S.L., process personal data as part of our exchanges with visitors, prospects, partners, members of the media, or job applicants, and more generally any users of the website <https://www.omniscope.ai> (the "Website").

OMNISCOPE's Privacy Policy (the "Privacy Policy") explains how your personal data may be used. The Privacy Policy can be amended depending on Data Protection laws, amendments, or guidelines provided by public authorities.

In this Privacy Policy the terms "OMNISCOPE", "we", "us", and "our" refer to OMNISCOPE LTD and its subsidiaries globally.

2. OMNISCOPE is a global company headquartered in Malta.

Our headquarters are in Malta. You acknowledge and consent that any data you provide or that we may collect may be used, processed and/or transferred to Malta or and to any location we are based in or other countries or territories as permitted under applicable law. We are compliant with GDPR non-EU data transfer per Section 6.4 below.

3. What's not covered by this Privacy Policy?

This Policy does not cover the following elements of data:

1. The receipt, creation, analysis, and/or storage of genomic or other data derived from people for research purposes (such as through customers' use of the OMNISCOPE platform or any other OMNISCOPE products or services);
2. the receipt, creation, analysis, and/or storage of genomic or other bio bank data derived from people for research and/or clinical research purposes.

Should you provide data not covered by this Privacy Policy to us, such data shall be covered by a specific contractual relationship, as well as the relevant laws and regulations applicable to you and/or us.

4. Categories of data we collect

We collect various types of data. As used herein, "Personal Data" means any information relating to an identified or identifiable person, who can be identified directly or indirectly.

We may collect the following categories of Personal Data:

1. Personal Data concerning the identity of visitors, prospects, or partners contacting OMNISCOPE via our contact form, including first names, last names, email address, phone numbers, country, organization, contact reason, and your message. These Personal Data are necessary to process your request. Our contact form limits the collection of Personal Data to what is necessary and indicates the required information to provide.
2. Personal Data concerning the identity of an applicant applying to an OMNISCOPE job posting, including first names, last names, email address, phone numbers, residence address, photography, birth date, nationality, residence permit, professional and academic background, CVs, cover letter, etc. These Personal Data are necessary to process your application. Each job application form limits the collection of Personal Data to what is necessary and indicates the required information to provide.
3. Personal Data concerning cookies, connection data and other pieces of information generated by a web server of visitors of the Website. See below for more information related to Cookies processing.
4. Personal Data derived from biological samples is governed in accordance with Maltese law.

5. Legal basis and purposes of processing of your Personal Data

We may process your Personal Data in accordance with the following legal bases:

1. The performance of a contract to which the data subject is party or in order to take steps at the request of the data subject prior to entering a contract, with regard to processing operations for the purpose of performance of contract, marketing operations, monitoring of the relationship between OMNISCOPE and its customer, prospect, partner, and applicant.
2. the legitimate interest pursued by OMNISCOPE regarding processing operations for the purpose of compiling statistics, marketing, promoting, and developing/improving OMNISCOPE'S products and services, the defense of OMNISCOPE'S rights and interests.
3. compliance with legal obligations applicable to OMNISCOPE regarding processing for invoicing and accounting purposes or the management of requests for the exercise of rights of the data subject.

6. Sharing of your Personal Data

As a general rule we do not provide, sell, or lease your Personal Data to any third parties for their marketing use without your express consent.

6.1 Service providers

We may rely on various third-party service providers and contractors to provide services that support the Website and our operations, including, without limitation, maintenance of our databases, distribution of emails and newsletters on our behalf, data analysis, payment processing, and other services of an administrative nature. Such third parties may have access to your Personal Data for the purpose of performing the service for which they have been engaged. However, such third-party providers shall remain under contractual obligations, particularly confidentiality obligations, for as long as they hold Personal Data from us.

6.2 Compliance with laws and law enforcement

OMNISCOPE cooperates with government and law enforcement officials and private parties to enforce and comply with the law. We may be required to disclose an individual's Personal Data in response to a lawful request by public authorities, including to meet national security or law enforcement requirements.

6.3 Business transfers

We may transfer your Personal Data to a third-party in the event of any corporate reorganization, merger, sale, joint venture, assignment, transfer, or other disposition of all or any portion of OMNISCOPE'S business, assets or stock.

6.4. External transfers of Personal Data in accordance with GDPR

To ensure compliance with the General Data Protection Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 ("GDPR") and applicable data protection law, we may not transfer your Personal Data to countries outside the European Union without an adequate level of protection. In the event of a transfer to a country whose legislation has not been recognized by the European Commission as providing an adequate level of protection within the meaning of the applicable data protection legislation, we undertake to sign with the recipient a data transfer contract including the standard contractual clauses of the European Commission.

7. Storage of your Personal Data

We may keep your Personal Data for no longer than is necessary for the purposes for which the Personal Data is processed. In this respect, Personal Data relating to our customers and/or partners shall be kept for the entire duration of our contractual relationship, plus an additional three (3) years for promotional use, without prejudice to any retention obligations or limitation periods. Personal Data concerning our prospects shall be kept for three (3) years from the time they are collected or from the last contact sent by the prospect, without prejudice to any retention obligations or limitation periods. Personal Data concerning our applicants shall be kept for two (2) years from the time they are collected or from the last contact sent by the applicant, without prejudice to any retention obligations or limitation periods.

8. Your rights

In accordance with GDPR and applicable data protection laws, you may access, review, update, correct, delete, restrict, object, and request data portability pertaining to your Personal Data. You may also file a complaint with a data protection authority, if you consider that any processing of your Personal Data infringes the requirements of the applicable data protection law. However, we invite you to contact us prior to doing so. If you would like to exercise one of your rights, please contact us at privacy@omniscope.ai with a copy of your identification card or any valid identification document with a signature. We may retain an archived copy of your request in accordance with GDPR and applicable data protection laws.

9. Limited use in our email list

If you no longer wish to receive new notices, email newsletters, or other future promotional communications from us, you may choose to unsubscribe by clicking on the link at the bottom of any such communication and following the instructions thereto. Alternatively, you may notify us by email at privacy@omniscope.ai with the word "remove" in the subject header, and we will

remove your name from our email recipient list within five (5) days. Opt-out is not possible for necessary service or other administrative and transactional notices.

10. Changes to Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy is effective as of the date of its last revision. We reserve the right to change this Privacy Policy at any time. When we make changes, we will post the changed Privacy Policy at the Website, and it will become effective immediately.

11. Security of your Personal Data

Considering the state of the art, the costs of implementation, and the nature, scope, context, and purposes of processing as well as the risk of varying likelihood and severity for the rights and freedoms of natural persons, we implement appropriate technical and organizational measures to ensure a level of security appropriate to the risk concerning your Personal Data.

12. Minors

The Website is not directed towards persons under the age of 16. We do not knowingly collect Personal Data from minors under the age of 16 who use the Website. If you become aware that a user under the age of 16 has used the Website, please contact OMNISCOPE at privacy@omniscope.ai. If we become aware that a child under 16 has provided us with Personal Data, OMNISCOPE will take the necessary steps to have that Personal Data irrevocably removed.

13. Your California Privacy rights (for users located in California)

Under California Civil Code Section 1798.83 (known as the “Shine the Light” law), OMNISCOPE customers who are residents of California may request certain information about our disclosure of personal information during the prior calendar year to our affiliates or to third parties and their direct marketing purposes. Cookies Policy

1. Overview

OMNISCOPE may process Personal Data concerning cookies, connection data and other such information generated by a web server, including device and browser type, operating system, Internet Protocol (IP) address (a number that is automatically assigned to your computer when you use the Internet and which may vary from session to session), domain name, URL, referrer and/or a date/time stamp for your visit ("Cookies") of visitors of the Website. This section explains how and why we use Cookies.

2. What is a cookie?

In general, a cookie is a small text file that is downloaded onto 'terminal equipment' (e.g., a computer or smartphone) when the user accesses a website. It allows the website to recognize that user's device and store some information about the user's preferences or past actions.

Subject to your choices, Cookies are used by the visited website to send information to your browser and allow that browser to send information back to the visited website.

Cookies allow the provider to store information about your browsing preferences during the validity of registration of Cookies.

3. What cookies are collected by us, for what purposes and how long?

4. Who may use Cookies?

We may process Cookies for the sole use of OMNISCOPE LTD and its subsidiaries, including without limitation Omniscope España S.L..

5. How do you consent to Cookies processing?

You acknowledge, recognize and accept that you have given your consent to Cookies processing if (i) you continue to navigate on the Website and (ii) you set your internet browser to allow Cookies processing.

Your consent is valid for a period of thirteen (13) months from the first deposit of Cookies in your terminal equipment.

By refusing this consent, you may still be able to access our Website, but some of the Website's functionalities may be limited.

6. How to change Cookie settings?
